is a way to proactively and publicly show support for children's education within our region. During the pandemic, the average U.S. public school student in grades 3-8 lost the equivalent of a half year of learning in math and a quarter of a year in reading. Affected students recovered only 20–30% of the lost ground in the first year, but then made no further recovery in the subsequent three to four years. Schools cannot be expected to be the sole solution with regards to achievement losses. We must create learning opportunities for students outside of the classroom. The Library's role of offering free access to books, information, technology, and cultural programming is vital to repairing educational gaps equitably within our very diverse community.

> Encouraging Early Literacy

Research suggests that reading aloud to children in an engaging manner promotes language development and emergent literacy. Furthermore, it can help develop a love for reading. To stress the importance of this research, the Little Read welcomes classes from local schools serving preschool through second grade to visit the Montclair Public Library and listen to stories read by adults in their community over a multi-day event. A daytime community lawn reading and an

evening community family party add the final touch to this celebration. A diverse array of authors and book subjects chosen by our staff helps to broaden the public view of what MPL can offer with regards to academic enrichment.

> Gathering the Community

In 2024, 14 classes participated in the Little Read from local public and pre-schools. More than 1,050 children sat for a story time either at the library, in a park, or at the YMCA. And nearly 40 adults volunteered to read throughout this multi-day story-time schedule. Guest readers have the option of reading at the Main Library where they get to sit in the "Big Red Chair" (which has become a widely-recognized symbol of the event) or reading at our beloved Branch building where many childhood memories are made. This signature event is so popular that we often have a waiting list of adult readers!



> Funding the Future

Sponsorship of **the Little Read** covers the nominal costs of hosting the event plus supports children's programming at the library throughout the year. For example, money raised through **the Little Read** sponsorships is used to purchase new books and to boost educational programming throughout the year ahead.
