

Margot Schwaab Sage-EL

Margot Schwaab Sage-EL was born and raised outside of Boston MA, earned her BA from Barnard College, and arrived in Montclair (after the usual UWS/Brooklyn route) in 1990. Embraced by a community of spirited souls passionate about art, politics, social justice and literacy,

Margot created Great Owl Books, a mail order catalog of multicultural children's books and folded that into Watchung Booksellers in 1996. She has spent the last three decades growing this community bookstore with the help of amazing booksellers, devoted readers, fabulous authors and a hugely supportive family. Margot and her husband Barry raised their three children, Trevor, Madeleine and Olivia, here and all benefited from the Montclair public school system. Margot was a founding member of the UUCM Undoing Racism Committee, served on the New Atlantic Independent Booksellers Association board of directors, and on the American Booksellers Association advisory board. She currently serves on the Montclair Public Library's Open Book/Open Mind advisory board, MPL Friends Steering Committee and Succeed2Gether's Montclair Literary Festival advisory board. Now with the bookstore under Maddie's leadership, Margot is semi-retired (still hosting those great author events!), totes her grandchildren around town, and is again pursuing sculpture.

Patrick Wilson

Patrick Wilson is an actor of stage and screen with a B.F.A. in Drama from Carnegie-Mellon University, best known for his role as demonologist Ed Warren in the *Conjuring* Universe. He began his career in 1995 starring in Broadway musicals and is a two-time Tony Award


nominee for his roles in *The Full Monty* and *Oklahoma!* He co-starred in the acclaimed HBO miniseries *Angels in America*, for which he received Golden Globe and Primetime Emmy Award nominations. Patrick has also appeared in films such as *The Phantom of the Opera, Hard Candy, Little Children, Watchmen, The A-Team,* and the *Insidious* series. On television, Patrick starred in the CBS drama *A Gifted Man* and as Lou Solverson in the second season of FX's anthology series *Fargo*, for which he received a second Golden Globe nomination. In the DC Extended Universe, he voiced the U.S. President in *Batman v Superman: Dawn of Justice* and later portrayed Orm Marius / Ocean Master in *Aquaman*, and *Aquaman and the Lost Kingdom*. Patrick made his directorial debut with *Insidious: The Red Door* in 2023. He lives in Montclair with his wife, actress Dagmara Domińczyk, and their two sons.



George Oliphant

George Oliphant is a multifaceted TV personality and skilled contractor known for his work on NBC's Emmy-winning show George to the Rescue. A Steamboat Springs, CO native and University of Colorado Boulder graduate, Oliphant started his career in regional children's theater before

becoming a competitive skier and extreme sports enthusiast. Early in his career, he worked as a "Gascaster" for Nickelodeon and was MTV's first VJ, launching the channel in 2003. His work at Vail Resorts earned him the title "Face of Skier Safety," and he later hosted MTV's *Music in High Def*. In 2007, he co-founded LXTV, which NBCUniversal acquired in 2008, and contributed to the show *1st Look*, showcasing his adventurous spirit through activities like skydiving and white-water kayaking. Oliphant's engaging real estate segment on *Open House* inspired the creation of *George to the Rescue*, where he and his team have transformed homes and lives through home improvement projects. Residing in Upper Montclair, New Jersey, with his wife, four children, and dog Sugar, Oliphant has been renovating his 1914 family home since 2009.


